Guidelines for Poster Presentations

Posters are considered and accepted for hard copy presentation

Once accepted presenters also have the option of providing an e-poster and/or flash presentation

Application

Please complete the [on-line application form](#) by midnight 24th November 2019

We will communicate whether your poster has been accepted by 29th November 2019.

Hard Copy Poster

Posters should be A1 (594 x 841 mm) or A0 (841 x 1,189 mm) in portrait orientation

Please bring your printed poster to the conference (It is not possible to print posters on-site)

Please take your poster with you when you leave the event

=> Posters that have not been removed by 2.00pm on Thursday 23 January will be disposed of

Electronic Poster

E-posters should be provided as a JPEG image (300dpi)

E-posters must be provided in advance.

It will not be possible to upload your presentation on the day of the event

Flash Presentation

Flash presentations should be prepared as a power point document

They should contain no more than a title and 2 slides

Each presenter will have the same amount of time to present

This will be confirmed before the event but is likely to be between 2 and 3 minutes

Presentations will not be allowed to overrun

Flash presentations must be provided in advance.

It will not be possible to upload your presentation on the day of the event
